



As the first Western-style modern building in Mokpo, the former Japanese Consulate was one of the two most significant Japanese consulates along with the one in Xiamen, China.



This building was used as the Mokpo Branch Office of the Oriental Development Company during the Japanese Colonial Period and was designated as Jeollanam-do Monument No. 174 on November 20. 1999. Today, the building is used as a museum, displaying pictures to celebrate the restoration of the building.



First Upland Cotton Farm


Gohado Cotton Farm, 863, Dal-dong

Cultivating upland cotton was first attempted on Gohado Island in 1899. When test plantation succeeded in 1904, upland cotton was distributed nationwide, and Mokpo became the major region producing "one black, three whites," which refers to seaweed, rice, salt, and cotton.





The National Maritime Museum at the National Research Institute of Maritime Cultural Heritage is a maritime archeology museum displaying a wide variety of cultural heritages found in the sea. It is a comprehensive culture exhibition hall where visitors can enjoy diverse kinds of maritime culture.



The Important Intangible Cultural Heritage Education Center was established to hand down state-designated, important intangible cultural heritages to younger generations and preserve them, continuing the legacy of Korean traditional cultures.



You can enjoy the works of three generations of Ullimsanbang Villa and Garden, from Heo Ryeon (pen-name: Sochi) to Heo Yeong (pen-name: Misan) to Heo Geon (pen-name: Namnong). Heo Ryeon was famous for his calligraphy and drawing during the end of the Joseon Dynasty and was highly admired by renowned calligrapher and painter Kim Jeong-hui (pen-name: Chusa).



Mokpo Literary House was opened to preserve and pass down the literary works of Korean authors. The exhibits in this museum show the lives and literary worlds of Korean writer Kim U-jin, female novelist Park Hwa-seong, and playwright Cha Beom-seok. An exhibition hall for literary critic Kim Hyeon is newly opened as well.
